God Announces Moses' Calling

Exodus 3:1-14

Every Doubt Brings An Excuse

Every doubt is removed when replaced by a faith in God's provision for the area of doubt.

Excuse Number 1 *"But how can I (and others) be sure that God has called me?"*

Exodus 4:1-5

Why should people believe that God spoke to me?

How can I be sure that God actually did speak to me?

Acts 10:9-48

God confirms His will in our lives through:

Visions, dreams

Circumstances, event, opening & closing doors

Confirming through "fleeces" (see Judges 6:36-40)

Advice of family, friends, spiritual leaders.

Sense of peace, confidence, and joy.

Excuse Number 2 *"I don't have all the skills."*

Exodus 4:10-12

How can I possibly do things for God if I don't have great faith or don't have great gifting?

Luke 21:15

Acts 1:8

Excuse Number 3 *"I can't do it alone."*

Exodus 4:13-15

The promises God has made sometimes doesn't make us feel confident. We need a helper.

God has prescribed that we should not be alone in our calling.

Mark 6:7 (NIV), John 14:16-18 (NASB), Deuteronomy 33:29 (NIV)

The Holy Spirit is our Helper. He helps us to have faith, say the right things at the right moments, and to be bold and passionate in pursuing our call.
